To: Lake Street Residents from Forest Glen to Scott Avenue

Re: Village of Winnetka 2016 Street Rehabilitation Project

Dear Residents:

The Village has awarded this year's road rehabilitation program to A Lamp Concrete Contractors, Inc. Lake Street is among several other roads to be rehabilitated during this construction season, but this section of Lake Street will also have a new water main constructed, and there is an existing water service that will need to be transferred to the new water main. In addition, localized repair of curb and sewer structure work will need to be done prior to the milling and resurfacing of your roads.

Starting on Monday, July 11, 2016, weather permitting, the Contractor will begin constructing the new water main and transferring the water services on Lake Street, between Forest Glen and Scott Avenue. Please be advised that when the water service is being transferred, that there will be a loss of water service to the home for a period of approximately 2 hours. The Contractor will notify affected residents prior to disconnection of the service. There is only 1 water service that will need to be transferred to the new water main. The Contractor estimates that both the construction of the new water main and the water service transfer should take approximately 1 week to complete, pending minimal utility conflicts and favorable weather conditions.

Prior to commencing the other phases of construction, including curb repair, milling and resurfacing the pavement, the Village will provide advance notice to the residents. Minor delays may be experienced throughout the duration of the project. During the various stages of construction, please do not park your vehicles on the roadway, as you will have access to your driveways during most of the construction process. **Please instruct any landscaping or other contractor that may be doing work on your property that no parking will be allowed on the street during construction. PARKING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON THE ROADWAY FOR THE DURATION OF EACH PHASE OF WORK.** Parking on the adjacent streets, as permitted by the signage, will be necessary.

Please note that all work will be performed within the Village right-of-way areas. If you have any type of existing private features within the Village right away areas (i.e. sprinkler system, landscape features, landscaping boulders, etc.), they should be removed and deactivated (sprinkler systems) as soon as possible and stored on your property to assure that damage does not occur to these items. The Village **will not** repair or replace private appurtenances left within the Village right-of-way.

Should there be any significant changes to this schedule; additional notices will be sent out to the affected homeowners.

Due to the scope, complexity and nature of the project, as well as unpredictability of weather, some delays and disruptions may occur. We ask for your understanding during these times. If you are planning a special event such as a wedding or large party during the summer, please contact us so that we can accommodate your needs as much as possible. The Village appreciates everyone's cooperation and patience during this project.
