Requirements

Applicants must meet the following requirements as of the date of application:

- **Certification** Certified as a Law Enforcement Officer by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training & Standards Board (certification as a part-time law enforcement officer does not meet this requirement). Individuals who are not certified in Illinois may apply through the entry-level process. Information about entry-level testing may be obtained by contacting the secretary of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners.
- **Experience** Prior law enforcement experience within the last 3 years.
- **Age** Must have passed 21st birthday and be eligible to participate in a Village pension fund.
- **Education** High school education or equivalent thereof and an associate's degree or at least 60 semester credit hours at an accredited college or university or demonstrate comparable work experience.
- **Vision** Correctable to 20/40, normal peripheral vision and able to distinguish colors
- **Driver's License** Valid-in-force driver's license
