Dear Mr. Hanold:

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Chicago District, has completed its review of your notification for authorization under the Lake Michigan Regional General Permit (LMRGP), submitted on your behalf by Shabica & Associates. This office has verified that your proposed activity complies with the terms and conditions of the LMRGP. The activity may be performed without further authorization from this office provided the activity is conducted in compliance with the terms and conditions of the LMRGP.

This verification expires three (3) years from the date of this letter and covers only your activity as described in your notification and as shown on the plans entitled "New Breakwater and Maintenance to Revetment – 151 Sheridan Road – Winnetka, Illinois 60093" dated May 2, 2021 (revised June 22, 2021), prepared by Shabica & Associates. Caution must be taken to prevent construction materials and activities from impacting waters of the United States beyond the scope of this authorization. If you anticipate changing the design or location of the activity, you should contact this office to determine the need for further authorization.

The activity may be completed without further authorization from this office provided the activity is conducted in compliance with the terms and conditions of the RGP, including conditions of water quality certification issued under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). If the design, location, or purpose of the project is changed, you should contact this office to determine the need for further authorization.

The permittee understands and agrees that, if future operations by the United States require removal, relocation, or other alteration of the structure or work authorized herein, or if, in the opinion of the Secretary of the Army or his authorized representative said structure or work shall cause unreasonable obstruction to the free navigation of the navigable water, the permittee will be required, upon due notice from the Corps of Engineers, to remove, relocate, or alter the structural work or obstructions caused thereby, without expense to the United States. No claim

shall be made against the United States on account of any such removal or alteration.

Please note that Section 401 Water Quality Certification has been issued by IEPA for this activity. If you have any questions regarding Section 401 certification, please contact Mr. Darin LeCrone at IEPA Division of Water Pollution Control, Permit Section #15, by telephone at (217) 782-0610.


