





How are you connected to the Hubbard Woods Business District? (Check all that apply)




How do you usually travel to Hubbard Woods?

When visiting the Hubbard Woods Business District by car, where do you typically park?




When do you typically visit Hubbard Woods?




Rank the streetscape functions that provide the most value

What about the Hubbard Woods public right-of-way (the roadways, sidewalks, plantings, and green spaces) is special and should be protected?

1. Sense of Place and Small Town Character
2. Hubbard Woods Park and Playground
3. Charming building storefronts and businesses
4. Convenient Traffic flow along Green Bay Road and Do not restrict travel with bumpouts.
5. Low speed limit along Green Bay Road
6. Mature trees in the park and along the street
7. Planters and green spaces
8. Outdoor seating and dining areas
