A record of a legally convened Special Meeting of the Winnetka Board of Fire & Police Commissioners, which was held in the Village Hall Conference Room (510 Green Bay Road) on Monday, May 20, 2019, at 5:00 p.m.

1) Call to Order. Chairperson Benson called the Special Meeting to order at 5:11 p.m.

Present: Chairperson Margaret (Meg) Benson, Commissioner Wes Baumann, Commissioner Ed Woodbury, Fire Chief Alan Berkowsky, Deputy Fire Chief John Ripka, and Benefits Coordinator Lizzy Storkman (Board Secretary).

2) Public Comment and Questions. None.

3) Approval of Minutes.

a) Commissioner Baumann moved to approve the minutes of the April 18, 2019 Board of Fire and Police Commissioners meetings as presented. The motion was seconded by Chairperson Benson. The motion carried 3-0.

5) Closed Session.

Commissioner Baumann moved to adjourn to closed session pursuant to Section 2(c)1 of the Open Meetings Act to conduct interviews for the position of Firemedic. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Woodbury. The motion carried 3-0.

a) Approval of Candidates for the Position of Firemedic

The motion was seconded by Chairperson Benson. The motion carried 3-0.

Staff will return to the Board following the completion of background and polygraph testing to update the board on its findings and, if appropriate, seek approval for a conditional offer of employment. Candidate Larry Matthies (#17), who was previously approved by the Board to complete his background and polygraph testing, is currently completing these steps in the recruitment process.

b) Removal of Candidates from the Firemedic Eligibility List
