## **Coin-Operated Amusement Device Regulations**

For a complete description of the regulations for coin-operated amusement devices please refer to Chapter 5.12 of the Winnetka Village Code. The following is a summary of the regulations:

- 1. An amusement arcade with coin-operated amusement devices shall operate in a space less than 1000 square feet and shall not possess a liquor license.
- 2. Each license for a coin-operated amusement device shall terminate on the last day of December of the year in which it was issued.
- 3. All holders of a coin-operated amusement device license shall comply with the following regulations:
  - a. Any license issued under the provisions of this section shall be affixed to or displayed in a conspicuous place within the establishment for which it was issued.
  - b. It shall be unlawful for: (i) any amusement arcade to operate a coin-operated amusement device between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m.; and (ii) a restaurant to operate a coin-operated amusement device between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m.
  - c. It shall be unlawful to permit a coin-operated amusement device that (i) has outdoor speakers or amplifiers, or (ii) emanates music or sound outdoors at a level of 50 decibels or greater.
  - d. A licensee that is a restaurant may not operate on the premises more than one coinoperated amusement device.
  - e. An amusement arcade must maintain and operate high definition video surveillance recording devices that monitor and record the portions of the licensed premises used for coin-operated amusement devices and must maintain all recordings from such devices for a minimum of thirty calendar days.
  - f. An amusement arcade must provide sufficient security measures to effectively regulate disturbing noise and light, loud conversations and criminal activities. During all hours of operation, amusement arcades shall have on duty at least one adult owner or manager who shall be responsible for, and shall supervise, all activities on the premises to insure that the provisions of this chapter and other applicable laws are complied with and that there is no conduct on the part of the licensee's customers, employees or other persons on the licensed premises that is detrimental to the public health, safety and general welfare. As a condition of issuing or continuing in effect any license issued under this chapter, the Village Manager may require additional attendants if it finds that adequate supervision cannot be maintained by one person.
- 4. No license shall be issued under this section to a person convicted of any larceny, embezzlement or any other offense involving fraud, nor to any person not of good moral character.
